- We have been asking the Lord for more young people for a long time and He is certainly using Lance and Heather to answer those prayers.
- 2. Lance and Heather have dedicated Charity, Sophia, and Josiah to the Lord here at CBC and they are dedicating Samuel today.
- 3. Dedicating children to the Lord serves as a good reminder that our children ultimately belong to the Lord. Parents and Grand-parents have the great honor and responsibility to love, provide, protect, and teach their children and grandchildren to trust the Lord and His Word.
- 4. <u>Deuteronomy 6:4-9</u> Hear, O Israel! The LORD is our God, the LORD is one! 5) "And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. 6) "And these words, which I am commanding you today, shall be on your heart; 7) and you shall teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up. 8) "And you shall bind them as a sign on your hand and they shall be as frontals on your forehead. 9) "And you shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.
- 5. <u>Ephesians 6:4</u> fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord.

 <u>Colossians 3:21</u> Fathers, do not exasperate your children, that they may not lose heart.

Parents should teach their children diligently and consistently <u>by both</u> <u>word and example</u>. Children should be disciplined when they need it, praised when they deserve it, and encouragement when they lack confidence or when they are afraid.

- 6. <u>Psalm 127:3-5</u> Behold, children are a gift of the LORD; The fruit of the womb is a reward. 4) Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, So are the children of one's youth. 5) How blessed is the man whose quiver is full of them;
 - vs. 4 Children help their aged parents and protect them as effectually as arrows in the hand of a warrior.
- 7. <u>Proverbs 22:6</u> Train up a child in the way he should go, And when he is old he will not depart from it.

Lance and Heather have done a phenomenal job of teaching and training their adorable children about God and His word and how to trust Him in all things. Training children is a round the clock job and it takes love, commitment, and time.

- 8. No family can function properly unless it is structured the way that God designed it to be; Lance and Heather's family certainly operates according to God's design.
 - a. <u>Colossians 3:18</u> Wives, be subject to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.
 - b. <u>Colossians 3:19</u> Husbands, love your wives, and do not be embittered against them.
 - c. <u>Colossians 3:20</u> Children, be obedient to your parents in all things, for this is well-pleasing to the Lord.
- 9. Read the Bishop email:

I just wanted to touch base about Samuel's dedication on Sunday. There is a particular hymn that we would like played if it is okay with you.

The song revolves around the life of Samuel - in particular when he was a young boy ministering at the tabernacle. As you may know, we named Samuel Joseph after two great men of the Bible and we pray that he displays the same humility, courage, obedience, faithfulness, and trust in God that these men displayed throughout

their lives. The lyrics to this hymn embody what our prayer is for Samuel as well as for each of our children and indeed for ourselves as well.
