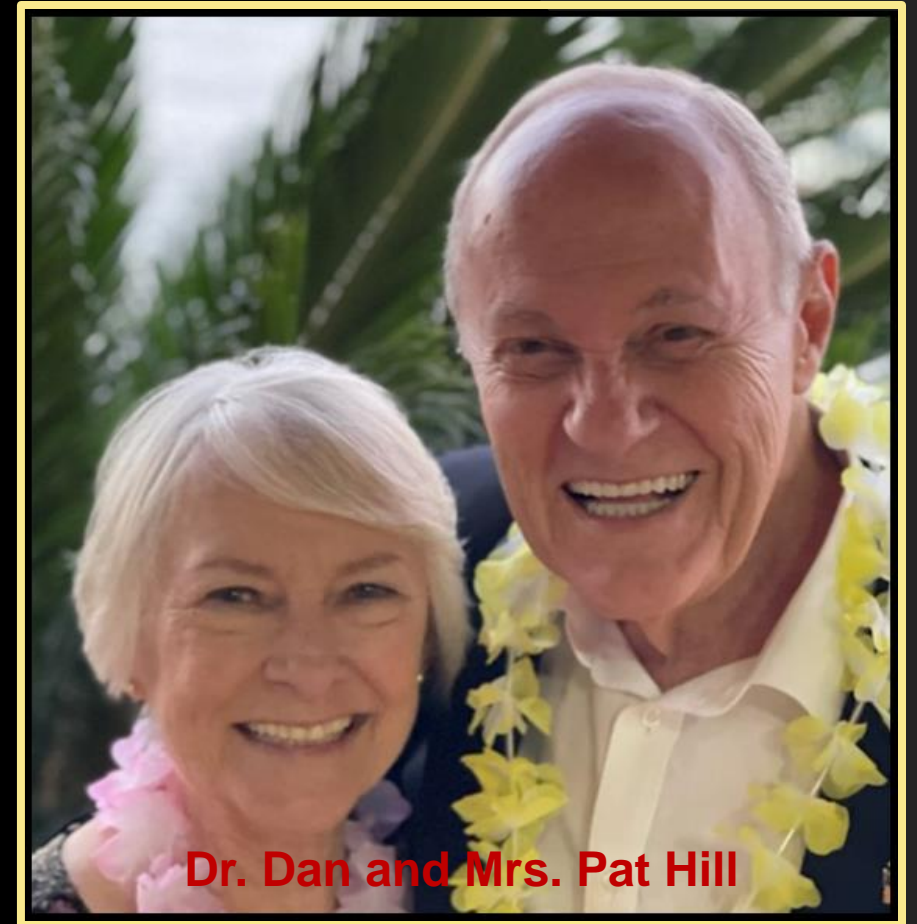

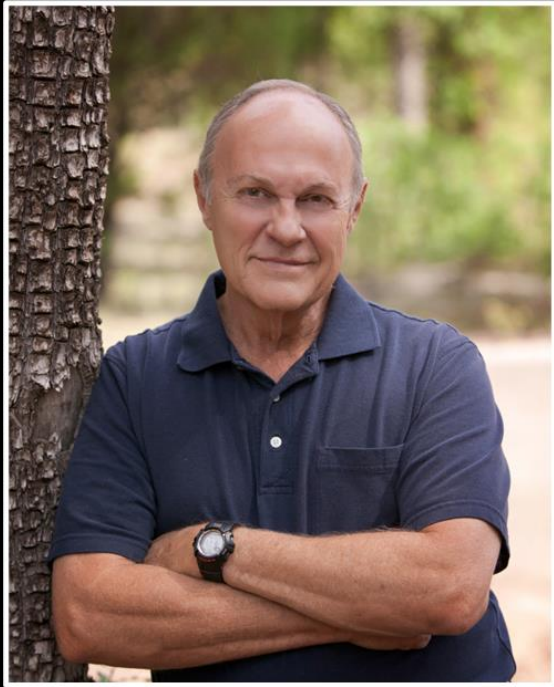


GO SERVE

Since our return to the U.S., after five years in Liberia, the Lord led us to start *Project 85*





- **Served in the US Military: US Navy Pacific Fleet Reserves**
- **Became a Christian at age 20**
- **Graduated from Arizona State University**
- **Taught in the Public Schools**
- **Masters from Dallas Theological Seminary**
- **Ph.D. from California Graduate School of Theology**
- **Pastored for 35+ years in the US, 20 of those years at Southwood Bible Church in Tulsa, Oklahoma USA**
- **Moved to Liberia in 2010 with Pat and served as a missionary with SIM for five years, returned in 2015**
- **Has written for Alpha Omega Publications, Grace Notes and has three books published by Amazon**
- **Adjunct Professor at AIU Zambia, ESWA Graduate Seminary Liberia, and Bold Grace Bible Institute Ghana**

I Chronicles 29:28

SUSTAINABILITY

A key concept in business, governance, churches, missions

The question is: Will what we plan and do (plan the work and work the plan) be good for now AND will it be sustainable for those in the future?

The lack of sustainability on the mission field can be historically observed where there was great evangelism but no training. Made believers who were going to heaven, but they were not trained to live the Christ Centered Life now.

Psalm 79:13

So we Your people and the sheep of Your pasture Will give thanks to You forever; To all *generations* we will tell of Your praise.

Ephesians 3:21

To Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all *generations* forever and ever.

In verses I Chronicles 28:8 through 10 we have three couplets, one in each verse (NASB):

v 8 Observe and seek

v 9 Know and serve

v 10 Be courageous and act

**The Inductive Bible Study Method:
Observation – Interpretation - Application**

Observe is *SHAW-MAW* a prime root that means to observe, keep, guard, and preserve.

Keep is *DAW-RASH* and is also used to investigate, inquire, or seek after.

KNOW is *YAW-DA* and means to discriminate and distinguish. This is where you come to understand what is being said, means. The interpretation of the words.

From that, you can then SERVE which is *ABAD*. Gill in his commentary says this means to serve cordially and sincerely, cheerfully and freely, not in a hypocritical manner, or through force and constraint, without loathing and weariness.

Colossians 3:2

Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth.

I Timothy 1:5

But the goal of our instruction is love from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith.

COURAGEOUS: Hebrew *CHA-ZAQ* and means to strengthen, prevail, harden, be strong, become strong, be courageous, be firm, grow firm, be resolute

And **ACT:** Just do it! *AS-AH*. The same word as in Genesis 2:18 when God *made* the woman, from existing materials, the rib of Adam.

There are three things I want you to remember from today's message:

- v 8 Observe and seek the Lord your God and His Word.** You have this church and a pastor who is doing his job, will you do yours?
- v 9 Know and serve.** From knowing God and His Word you will also know how to serve Him
- v 10 Be courageous and act.** Your courage will come from the Holy Spirit for is it not by might or by power but by God's Spirit that we can act

Just do it!
